Dan Zhang is currently working as Counselor with the Mission of China to UN, responsible for human rights and development related issues. Prior to joining the Mission, she worked as the Director of the Department of International Organizations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, responsible for relations of China with APEC (Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation). Before that, she worked on social development, gender equality, refugees, health and many other development issues and was once assigned to work in the Commissioner's Office of the Foreign Ministry of China in Hong Kong. She has attended many important UN meetings throughout her diplomatic career, including the Fourth World Conference on Women. She has headed the Chinese delegation to several sessions of NGO Committee of ECOSOC and as alternate representative of China to the Commission on Social Development (CsocD) and the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW).
