

The seeds of the Atomic bomb survivor Jujube tree (*Ziziphus jujuba*) which was located less than 1,5 km from the bomb's hypocenter, picked by the Green Legacy Hiroshima team in the autumn of 2011, have safely arrived at the Amsterdam botanical garden (<http://en.dehortus.nl/homepage>) -- soon be planted in the garden's beautiful greenhouse. It is hoped that under the loving care of the Hortus staff, they will thrive and grow into strong, resilient trees -- conveying to all in their new home the message of peace and resilience of Hiroshima, and the longing of all atomic bomb survivors for a world free of the threats and devastation of nuclear weapons
