MDP facilitates solution-finding for some of the world’s greatest diplomatic challenges

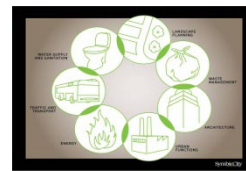
The Multilateral Diplomacy Programme (MDP) looks back on a successful strategic partnership with the government of South Africa in 2011.

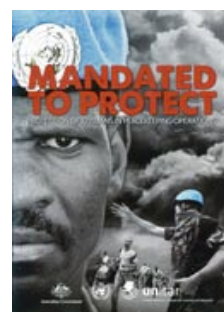
UNITAR, the Government of Sweden and SKL International start “SymbioCity” partnership
