6 TYPES OF E-COURSES



Moderated Courses

- Follows a curriculum over a period of time (6 – 12 weeks)
- Careful selection of participants (small group)
- Personalized feedback and facilitated discussion
- Certificate provided

Examples: [Introduction to Green Economy](#), [Introduction to Sustainable Consumption and Production](#)



E-tutorials

- Short teaser course (20 – 30 minutes)
- Provides an introduction to a subject
- Works well when blended with face-to-face
- Open to the public
- No moderation
- No certificate

Examples: [Climate Policy and Public Finance](#), [Climate Responsive Budgeting](#)



Self-paced modular courses

- Self-paced
- Modular course, each module focuses on a thematic area
- Open to the public, large number of participants, less interaction between learners
- No moderation
- Certificate provided after completion of all modules

Examples: [Introductory e-course on Climate Change](#) (various languages available)



Blended courses

- Short course or e-tutorial followed by a face-to-face training
- E-learning may vary in length, structure, certification, moderation
- Completion of e-learning is necessary for participation in the face-to-face training
- E-learning can be integrated into day 1 of face-to-face training

Self-paced short courses

- Self-paced, shorter in period (2 – 3 hours)
- Focuses on one specific thematic area
- Open to the public, large number of participants
- No moderation
- Certificate provided

Examples: [Children and Climate Change](#), [Human Health and Climate Change](#), [Cities and Climate Change](#)



Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs)

- Follows a curriculum over a period of time
- Availability for the general public
- Interaction between learners
- Certificate provided
