## SECTION I – Comments on Findings, Conclusions

• Comments made after the first submission were only partially taken into account. The biggest limitation of the evaluation (i.e. project still ongoing) is not mentioned anywhere and findings attribute the non-measurability of the impact only to a weak logical framework.

• In several parts of the report, information are presented in a very unstructured manner. The link between outcome – output – activity – evaluation results is far from being clear and we are seriously concerned that this may lead to misunderstandings (please refer to comments in the report).

• Report still presents several inaccuracies that were not addressed after the first round of comments (please refer to comments in the report).

• Layout can be substantially improved.
