



our discussion today is far from positive. Humanitarian concerns remain prevalent throughout the world. In fact, the Global Humanitarian Overview 2022 notes that nearly 300 million people in 63 countries are in need of humanitarian assistance. The United Nations and partners will target assistance to 183 million of those most in need — the greatest number ever. That assistance comes at a financial cost. The Global Humanitarian Overview 2022 calls for \$41 billion the largest appeal ever made. I urge the international community to support the appeal. We have a moral obligation to protect and provide for the most vulnerable. Let us live up to those ideals. Our discussion today is focused on how we can strengthen the coordination of disaster and humanitarian relief assistance. In that regard, I will emphasize four key points.

First, we cannot ignore the impact of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19).
